Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the accounts, products or services you have with us. This information can include:  Name, address, Social Security Number, and income  Account balances and payment history  Credit history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Vibrant Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Vibrant Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you  • Apply for an account  • apply for a loan  • use your credit or debit card  • pay your bills  • make deposits to or withdrawals from the accounts you have with us  We also collect your personal information from others, including credit bureaus or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law only gives you the right to limit:  • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness  • affiliates from using your information to market to you  • sharing for non-affiliates to market to you  State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on the account you have with us – unless you tell us otherwise.	

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control.  They can be financial and nonfinancial companies that include the following:  Investment service providers  Food and beverage service providers  Clothing and merchandise companies
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control.  They can be financial and nonfinancial companies that include the following:  • Equipment manufacturing companies  • Equipment dealers and sales companies
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our marketing partners include:  • Investment companies  • Insurance companies  • Mortgage companies  • Credit card issuers and servicers  • Other financial service providers
